

## KS1 English Quiz - Narrative - First Person (Questions)

This quiz focusses on first person narrative. This quiz teaches KS1 children that when they write 'I', they are writing in the first person and that they should continue to write in a specific narrative. This quiz will aid their creative writing and improve their all-round knowledge of literacy and the English language. If you write a story and it's from your point of view and written as if you are talking to the reader - then this is called first person narrative. If I write 'I went to the park' - then I am writing in first person. Test your knowledge on writing and staying in first person narrative

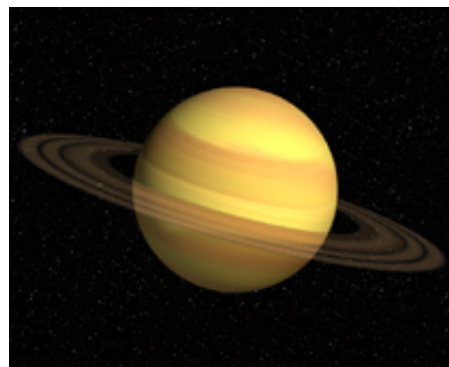

When writing in first person, you can be writing about real life events or made up stories.

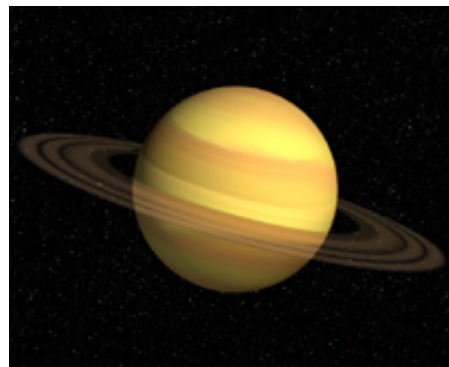

The first answer was nearly correct but the second sentence slipped out of first person narrative. It's tricky but make sure you always stay in first person narrative if that's how you start your story!

When writing in first person, try not to keep saying 'I did this, I did that...' Make sure you use 'my' or 'me' when you can.

The most common ways to write are in first person and third person narrative. When you write in one narrative, you have to make sure you stay there!
