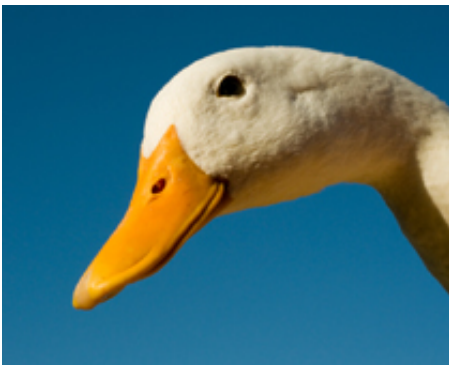

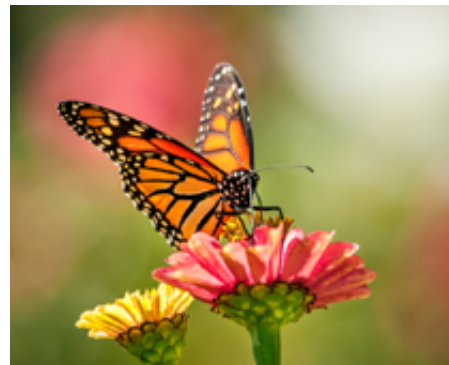

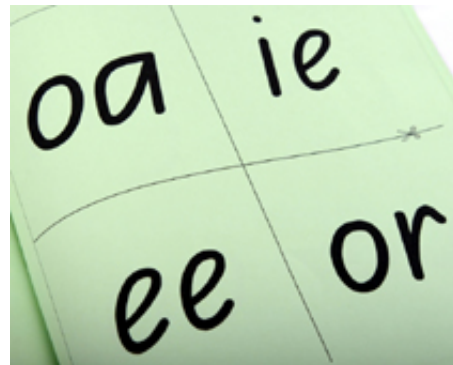

The word should be broken up like this: h + ear + i + ng.

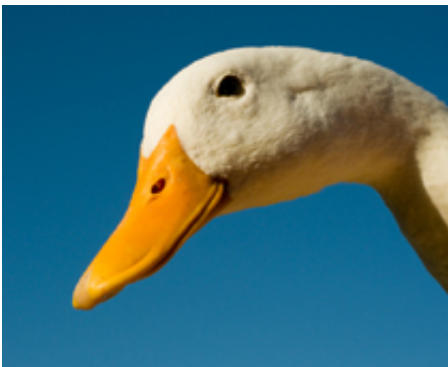
2. He said stop. What is the second sound in the word 'said'?

The word said should be broke up like this: s + ai + d.

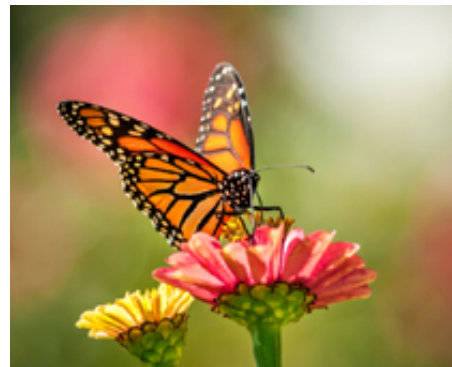
3. Ducks go quack. What is the first sound in the word 'quack'?

Because you pronounce the 's' and the 't' - we consider them to be two different sounds.

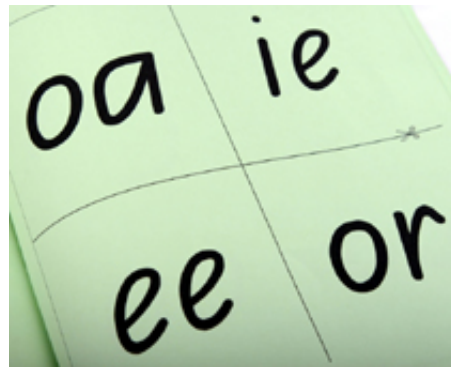
