

## KS1 English Quiz - Verbs - Past Tense (Irregular) 2 (Questions)

This English and Literacy quiz is our second on Irregular Past Tense. This quiz helps children in KS1 identify the change in certain verbs when writing them in the past tense. This quiz will also help children achieve the National Curriculum's requirement of writing within a specific tense. There are many irregular past tense words and it's important for children to learn these 'oddities', as it will add to their growing literacy and English knowledge.

Sometimes, to show a verb happened in the past, we can just add 'ed' to that word. However, there are some verbs that when moved from the present to past tense, change completely. These are called irregular past tense words.

1. Which sentence is correct and written in the past tense?



- I sing in the car.
- I singed in the car.
- I sanged in the car.
- I sang in the car.

2. Which sentence is correct and written in the past tense?



- The fire burnt down the house.

1. Which sentence is correct and written in the past tense?



- I sing in the car.
- I singed in the car.
- I sanged in the car.
- I sang in the car.

You just need to change the vowel in this word to show it happened in the past.

3. Which sentence is correct and written in the past tense?



- I meeted my friends.
- I met my friends.
- I meet my friends.
- I meets my friends.

If you are going to meet your friends then it is in the future, if you meet them then you are doing it now and if you met them, you did it yesterday.

2. Which sentence is correct and written in the past tense?



- The fire burnt down the house.
- The fire barnt down the house.
- The fire burn down the house.
- The fire burnet down the house.

The colours of flames vary depending on what material has been set alight.

4. Which sentence is correct and written in the past tense?



- I kept the treasure!
- I keep the treasure!
- I keeped the treasure!
- I kepted the treasure!

Treasure hunting still happens today but often, people use a metal detector to find coins.

5. Which sentence is correct and written in the past tense?



- The helicopter flown in the air.
- The helicopter flew in the air.
- The helicopter flied in the air.
- The helicopter flyed in the air.

The word 'fly' changes to 'flew', so 'you will fly in the air' changes to 'you flew in the air'.

7. Which sentence is correct and written in the past tense?



- I saw you.
- I see you.
- I seed you.
- I sawed you.

The word 'see' changes to 'saw' and the word seesaw is a ride in the park!

6. How do you change the word 'fight' to the past tense?



- fought
- foughted
- faght
- foughted

Fight is the present tense way of saying it but if you have already fought - then it's already happened!

8. Which sentence is correct and written in the past tense?



- I find treasure.
- I finded treasure.
- I founded treasure.
- I found treasure.

This word changes quite a bit - it goes from 'find' to 'found'.

9. Which sentence is correct and written in the past tense?



- He hear his friend on the other end.
- He heard his friend on the other end.
- He hoard his friend on the other end.
- He heard his friend on the other end.

Normally we add 'ed' to show something happened in the past. This word is an irregular past tense because we don't add 'ed', we just add 'd'.

10. Which sentence is correct and written in the past tense?



- I run a race.
- I runned a race.
- I ran a race.
- I ranned a race.

Here, we change the word 'run' to 'ran'.
