

KS1 Geography Quiz - Life in Bangladesh (Questions)

This quiz addresses part of the requirements of the National Curriculum KS1 for children aged 5 and 6 in years 1 and 2 in Geography. Specifically it looks at life in Asian countries like, for example, Bangladesh. It is one of 50 quizzes to help you understand the world around you.

This is one of three quizzes looking at life in other countries - Cameroon, Bangladesh and Brazil. In geography at school you will have looked at what places are like in different parts of the world. You will have found out a little bit about the houses people live in, the jobs they do and what life is like. Bangladesh is an Asian country just north east of India. In this quiz we look a little bit at life in rural Bangladesh.
