

KS1 Maths Quiz - Year 1 Time - Hours, Minutes or Seconds (Questions)

This quiz addresses the requirements of the National Curriculum KS1 Maths and Numeracy for children aged 5 and 6 in year 1. Specifically this quiz is aimed at the section dealing with measuring and recording time.

Hours, minutes and seconds are the different units of time measurement children in Year 1 will be expected to understand. They may know that there are 60 seconds in a minute and 60 minutes in an hour, but they should certainly appreciate that an hour is longer than a minute and a minute is longer than a second and perhaps even begin to count up to 60 to record 1 minute.

This quiz will help your child both to measure and to record time.

It doesn't take too long to eat a sandwich

- 25 seconds
- 42 minutes

It takes several hours to get from Scotland to London by train

6. What could you do in an hour?

- Have a holiday
- Have a night's sleep
- Fly to France
- Have a swimming lesson

All the others would take much longer than an hour!

7. Which is shortest?

- 2 seconds
- 2 minutes
- 2 hours
- 2 days

2 seconds is the same as counting up to 2

8. What could you do in one minute?

- Brush your hair
- Read 20 books
- Run a bath and have it
- Eat a 3 course meal

Only brushing your hair would take a minute or less!

9. Which of the units of time is the shortest?

- A second
- A minute
- A day

A second is very short indeed

10. Which is longest?

- 4 hours
- 5 hours
- 2 hours
- 6 hours

6 hours is longest
