Hinduism is a religion and if you follow this religion, you are called a Hindu. Can you answer these questions?

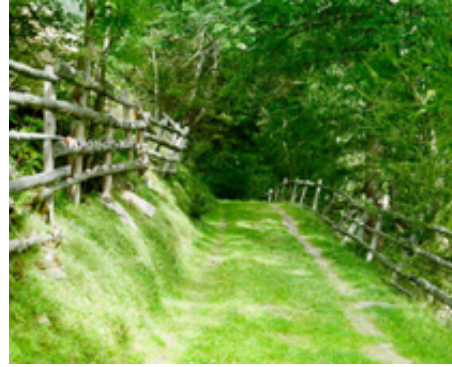
