

KS1 Science Quiz - Plants - Growing and Caring for Plants (Questions)

This quiz addresses the requirements of the National Curriculum KS1 Science for children aged 5 and 6 in years 1 and 2. Specifically this quiz is aimed at the section dealing with caring for and growing plants.
