

KS1 Spelling Quiz - Year 1 - Magic e Review (Questions)

This Magic e Review spelling quiz will show KS1 children single clause sentences with magic e spellings. They will need to remember how to apply this rule and identify the correct and perfectly-spelt sentence. Although concentrating on magic e, children should try not to neglect the other spellings and so some sentences will have other HFW (High Frequency Words) spelt incorrectly.

You've completed the tests on Magic 'e' words and now is the time to see what you've learnt.

1. Which sentence has all the correct spellings for magic e words?



- He maide a cake.

Both made and cake have the 'a' sound, which changes from 'ah' to 'aye' when there is a magic e on the end of the word.

2. Which sentence has all the correct spellings for magic e words?



- These pictures will fade.
- These pictures will fade.
- Thess pictures will fade.
- Thesse pictures will fade.

The magic e words are 'These' and 'fade'. The pictures in this image are called Polaroids and are taken from a Polaroid camera.

The word 'those' is a high frequency word; this means it's a word you will use quite a lot.

Although the word 'come' ends with a magic e, it doesn't change the 'oh' to 'ow' (like show); instead it changes to 'uh'.
