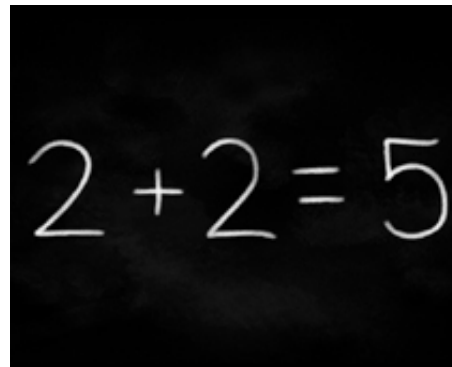

Hedgehogs are called nocturnal - this means they are mostly awake in the night and sleep through the day.

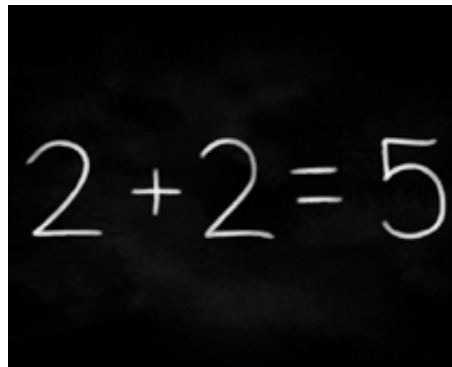
