

## KS2 English Quiz - Adverbs 01 (Questions)

This KS2 English quiz takes a first look at adverbs. Adverbs are words that change verbs, adjectives and other adverbs. Adverbs play several roles in English sentences. One of these is to modify (or change) the verb by making it more precise. For example, 'she stepped stealthily into the room' is not the same as 'she stepped suddenly into the room'. The adverbs, 'stealthily' and 'suddenly', alter the verb 'stepped' to create different effects.

Using adverbs can really improve your writing. As an example, using the adverb 'angrily' in this sentence - 'He angrily kicked the ball' - makes the reader want to read more to find out why he was angry.




 Find the adverbs in the following sentence.
 She whispered the secret carefully into her best friend's ear.

'Carefully' is an example of an adverb which has been formed by adding the suffix, '-ly', to the end of an adjective.

2. Find the adverbs in the following sentence. "Who broke the dish?" my little brother asked innocently.



- [ ] Who
- [ ] broke
- [ ] little
- [x] innocently

'Innocently' affects the verb 'asked' - it describes how the question was asked.

3. Find the adverbs in the following sentence.
They gazed absentmindedly at their feet during the teacher's fifth explanation of the work.

The word 'absentmindedly' is 14 letters long and means lost in thought or distractedly.

'Poorly' changes the verb 'played' - it describes how the team played.

'Oozed' is the verb and 'sloppily' describes how the syrup oozed.

7. Find the adverbs in the following sentence.
Slipping on the treacherous ice, my sister landed awkwardly.

'Landed' is the verb and 'awkwardly' describes how she landed.

8. Find the adverbs in the following sentence.
The nurse spoke gently, but removed the bandage carelessly.

- [x] gently, carelessly
- [ ] removed, bandage

'Gently' describes how the nurse spoke, while 'carelessly' describes how she removed the bandage. Compare the effect of this sentence: The nurse spoke carelessly, but removed the bandage gently.



9. Find the adverbs in the following sentence. She tried hard, but failed to hit the target.



- [x] hard
- [ ] failed
- [ ] hit
- [ ] the

'Hard' changes the verb 'tried', so here it is an adverb. In the phrase, 'the hard ground', 'hard' is an adjective because it describes the noun 'ground'.

10. Find the adverbs in the following sentence.
The car went so fast, it appeared to be a blur.



- [ ] went, fast
- [x] so, fast
- [ ] appeared, blur
- [ ] be, blur

'So' and 'fast' are both adverbs here.
